POOL RULES

- Pool hours are from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm daily.
- The pool is for the exclusive use of association members and their guests only. Each household is allowed two (2) guests. All guests must be accompanied by the association member.
- Admittance into the pool area is granted by pool access card to association members in good standing. Anyone causing damage to the property will be held responsible.
- Entry gates to the pool are to remain closed and locked always and not propped or blocked open or otherwise left unsecured.
- Pool area cannot be exclusively reserved by association members.
- Do not open the pool entry to let in unsupervised children or guests. Do not open the pool entry for someone who does not have their pool access card.
- No children under 12 years of age are permitted in the pool area without an adult over the age of 18 years of age. Any child who cannot swim must be accompanied by an adult in the water and/or wear a properly fitted U.S. Coast Guard approved life vest. Do not swim alone.
- No running, diving, horseplay, or otherwise unsafe acts are allowed in the pool area.
- Report unsafe, vulgar, obnoxious or criminal activity to the Melissa Police Department.
- Smoking is not allowed in the entire pool facility.
- No alcoholic beverages in the pool or pool area. No glass containers of any kind.
- No portable grills or cooking equipment of any kind are allowed inside the fenced area of the pool.
- Shower or wipe off all oils and lotions before getting in the pool. Shower is available on side of pool building.
- Appropriate swimwear only. No cutoff shorts or jeans.
- NO DIAPERS IN THE POOL. Non-potty trained children must wear swim diapers. No diaper changing on the pool deck. Use the restroom facilities.
- Use of pool furniture is first come, first serve. No reserving pool furniture.
- Do not put the pool furniture in the pool.
- No pets in the fenced area of the pool. No pets allowed in the pool. Service dogs are allowed.
- No abusive language or loud music. Music playing devices are to be kept at a level that does not disturb others in the pool area. Be respectful of each other's time at the pool.
- No bicycles, roller blades or skateboards allowed inside fenced area of pool facility.
- Please pick up all your belongings before you leave. The Association assumes no responsibility for the loss, theft or damage to personal property or effects left in the pool area by residents and their guests. The Association assumes no responsibility for any personal injury to anyone from the use of the pool facility or the pool.
- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. Swim at your own risk.
- Evacuate the pool immediately in the event of thunder and/or lightning.
